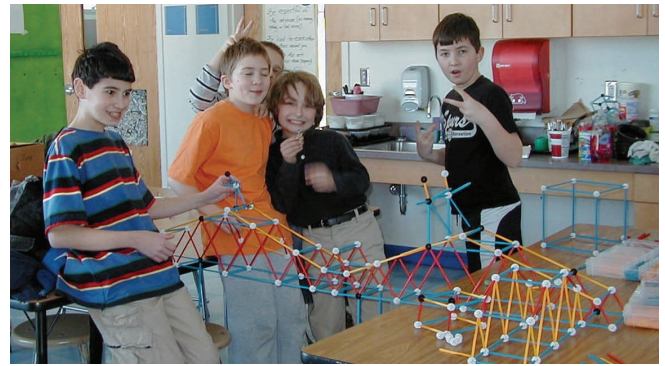


Thompson Recreation, with support from NECASA (Northeast Council Against Substance Abuse), presents
